During Mardi Gras, the churches try to have retreats for their young people to get them away from the very worldly activities that go with that holiday. It was a special time for the Pearts this year as they hosted nearly forty young people from their two church plants. The Pearts are encouraged by the spiritual growth they are seeing as they have watched these kids grow up. I am blessed by the role the clinic ministry has in supporting these church planters.

Improved eyesight has made it much easier to get foreign bodies out of eyes and to enjoy doing minor surgery. It also means I can see the mountain ridges with the lonely trees standing out. I have been reminded of the vision God demonstrated for both Jews, His chosen people, and Gentiles, who were considered far off. I would have His vision for individuals no matter where they are.

Praise I passed the American Board of Surgery exam, and am board certified through 2024.

God has given me good health, and I plan to continue working in the clinic ministry here in Haiti until at least age 70, as He wills.

Projects The columns and beams were poured for the ministry residence in February, and some of the walls are in place. The next job is pouring the roof and installing the internal stairway, and it all has to happen at the same time. Estimated cost--\$18,000; on hand—about \$4000.



I am seeking advice for the paperwork necessary to be sure the clinic is an entity recognized by the Haitian government, preferably a non-profit. Then we can move the deeds for the property to the Haitian organization.

Prayer There are many older patients who come to the clinic. Those who are saved have the assurance of being with their Lord when they die. But we have patients who have heard the Gospel many times and still want to wait before making a decision. Please pray that they will understand they have already made a choice by waiting, that it is the wrong one, and that they need to trust Jesus Christ now.

Jesus said, “I am the light of the world.” He came to the Jews first, but it is clear that God never meant to leave the Gentiles groping in spiritual darkness. Christ died and rose again that all might be saved. We have the privilege of reflecting His light into a dark world so that individuals can see and come to Him.
