I saw my surgeon today, and he is satisfied with the results of surgery. He does not have any problems with my tentative return to Haiti on April 2. (The current problems in Haiti may cause a delay, but that is not his fault!) There are no restrictions on movement, which means I can finally do things like wash my feet and tie my shoes. I do not need to return for a return visit until early next year.

Therapy continues, and will continue through this month. That is another area that is going well. I can tell that my strength is gradually increasing, and so is my confidence with everyday activities. It has been interesting to discover how much time exercises and therapy take.
