The "Hallelujah!" chorus from Handel's *Messiah* has always been one of my favorite pieces of music to sing. **Projects** There are two plumbing jobs that need to be done at the Ministry Residence. Harry Peart has given some advice, and now I need to get more information and some parts.

We have electrical lines throughout the Ministry Residence, with power coming from the solar system. Our goal is an integrated system using public power (when available), the solar system and the generator. We have some of the supplies, and need to purchase other items.

I want to purchase equipment to keep the grass and weeds on the property under control. People have already given generous gifts that will cover the costs.

**Prayer** My plans are to return to Haiti on January 11, as our Lord wills. There will be lots of packing and a 600-mile drive to Ft. Pierce, Florida, after I return from Christmas in Lansing, Michigan.

The clinic staff has been seeing patients during my absence. I need to discuss some issues with my workers soon after I return.

The beloved Son, the victorious Lamb who died and is alive forevermore, is worthy to receive all that the Father bestows on Him. What is so amazing is that He receives the kingdom and all that goes with it, and then shares it with His redeemed people, making them kings and priests to God. Truly, the Lamb is worthy, "to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing." (Revelation 5:12)  
Amen, and amen!
